# **Checklist: Steps to Request Advocacy Support from JNCL-NCLIS**

#### **Confirm Eligibility**

- ☐ Are you the official delegate of a JNCL-NCLIS member organization?
- → Only official delegates can formally submit support requests.

### **Complete the Support Request Form**

- □ Use the designated <u>Advocacy Support Request Form</u> to provide:
- Background on the issue
- Timeline of events
- Stakeholders involved
- Desired outcomes and support needed
- → Filling out the form will help clarify your advocacy goals and strategy.

#### **Consider In-State Coordination**

- □ Organize a collaborative in-state approach with:
- Your state association
- Local educators or administrators
- Other relevant advocacy groups
- → Unified local efforts are most effective and credible.

## **Explore Strategic Options**

- □ With JNCL-NCLIS guidance and <u>advocacy resources</u>, consider actions such as:
- A call-to-action or letter-writing campaign
- Letters of support from associations and allies
- Media or public awareness efforts
